The Kanegasaki stronghold of Nishine village has its border in the Morioka domain to the west of the Kitakami River in the Sendai domain and in 1644, Omachi Bizen Sadayori came to occupy it at the behest of Date Masamune. He is said to have arranged the town centered around the Kanegasaki Castle, the Oshu Road, and the Kitakami River. The way the town was arranged by Omachi hundreds of years ago has been passed down to the present.
